### SEND E-MAIL LINKS

- 1) Tick the box marked Add to Collection Maker located in the upper right-hand corner of the page and that page will be added to your collection.

- 3) If you want to edit your collection (delete a page or change the page order), simply hover over the symbols on the right-hand side of each entry and choose the appropriate action. The X option will delete the page, and the up and down arrows will change the page order.

- 4) To send your collection, choose the *Create Email Collection* option. In most cases your email program will open automatically with links to all the pages in your collection already included in the message section. All you need to do is write a message and send the email. If the links do not appear automatically in the message section, return to *Fountain Collection Maker* and select *Create Collection List*. The links will appear on the screen. You can then copy and paste the links directly into the email.
